TAKAMOL ACCREDITATION; ANOTHER FEATHER IN THE CAP

Takamol is a subsidiary of the Government of Saudi Arabia. Pakistan and Saudi Arabia have signed a momentous agreement for certification and employment of Pakistani skilled workforce through Takamol and NAVTTC. A team comprising NAVTTC and Takamol Officials visited DTI to assess its processes and trainings, and shortlisted the institution for its Takamol Program. Through this partnership, NAVTTC and Takamol are establishing a testing regime under the Skills Verification Program, by exchanging the National Occupational Standards and facilitating skill verification of candidates through competency-based assessment (Theory and Practical) at exam centers in Pakistan, for candidates desirous of working in the KSA. A total of 11 aspirants from DTI, with the required skill set of electrician trade, participated in the program and all of them successfully qualified the SVP Test.
